**REQUIREMENTS FOR THE APPLICATION OF
WAIVER OF EXCLUSION GROUND (WEG)**

All applications for WEG for non-Filipino travellers arriving at NAIA I or NAIA CT II who are below fifteen (15) years old, neither accompanied by or not coming to join a parent in the Philippines, shall be signed and approved by the Head Supervisor, BI-NAIA, subject to the following conditions:

1. Submission of affidavit of request, and consent by either parent or legally appointed guardian of the child, naming therein the person who will be accompanying the child to the Philippines and with whom the child will reside in the country. This Affidavit must be executed before any Notary Public and authenticated by the Philippine Embassy (please see requirements for Embassy authentication);
2. Clear photocopy of the data page of the child's passport;
3. Clear photocopy of the data page of the passport of the accompanying adult; and
4. Payment of immigration fees.
